Trained as an architect, Jérôme Bryon plays with lines and scales to transfigure an ordinary environment. By making the invisible visible, it sublimates the raw material. Graduated DEFA of Architecture in 1996 and from the Gobelins School of Paris in 1998, he is influenced by both architecture and Russian constructivism, Jérôme Bryon tears away from the real his everyday, anodyne 'sculptures', which he isolates in order to better reveal their structural potential, their abstract reality.
