Born in 1984 in Tokyo - Lives and works in Brussels

"My painting opens onto an inner world made of transparencies, lightness, tectonic movements, traces and reliefs, chasms. It gives us the opportunity to see and feel an intimate journey, on the edge, silent. It is nourished by reminiscences of sensations. First, there is a moment of encounter with the world, experienced with intensity, which I immerse myself in. Then oblivion erases the sharp precision of reality. I look for a language made of crumpled papers, ink, reliefs and traces, to give shape to these moments that have been erased and yet have left their mark.

This work of recollection and condensation attempts to restore the energy of these moments. It is not a question of a specific landscape, or of recognising a particular object, but rather, as oriental painters do so well, it is a question of gathering in oneself and letting this primary energy re-emerge in a movement of transformation.

Through the slow elaboration of a composition combining painting, collage and engraving on wood (*Dépaysages* series), the superimposition of Japanese paper veils that I paint (*Ouranos* series), or even installations (*Ecran - rêve*, *Monde - flottant*).
