



Christian Renonciat

Born in Paris in 1947 – Lives and works in Paris

Born in 1947, Christian Renonciat studied at the Sorbonne and earned a degree in philosophy. In 1969, he joined an art workshop in Antibes, where he practiced woodworking crafts for six years. In 1975, he opened his own studio in Valbonne, where his first sculptures were born. Back in Paris, Christian Renonciat exhibited for the first time in 1978, at the Alain Blondel gallery.

Renonciat seeks to achieve a sensuality of perception in order to awaken the knowledge held in touch. His works speak to our ears and to our hands. The artist's intervention on materials - paper, plastic, or wool - to achieve exact modeling and precise folds is spectacular. Renonciat sets spectacle aside, leaving us entirely to the pleasure of the line, the softness of the curve, the tremor of the fold.

Since 1984, Christian Renonciat has pursued a second, parallel path : monumental creation, in which he blends imagination and technique across a wide range of materials (cast steel, bronze, aluminum, gardens), often with the tone of a dreamlike archaeology.

Today, he rediscovers the material essence of things in large wall compositions of carved wood, resembling tapestries of cloth, plastic, wool, paper, or cardboard.

His work is regularly exhibited in France, Switzerland, Belgium, the USA, Japan, China, South Korea, and elsewhere. Some of his installations can be found in Tokyo, Sapporo, Atlanta, San Francisco, Monte Carlo, London, Seoul, Aytré, La Rochelle, Paris, Issy, Reims, Saumur, and other cities.
